| Award | The award consists of a prize-lecture, a medal with an illuminated address, and an honorarium of a thousand euro. | |
| Calls | A call for nominations is announced by FEMS at least twelve months before the award of the prize. It is published on the FEMS website and in other FEMS publications, and anywhere else, if appropriate. | |
| Nominations | Members of FEMS Council, national microbiological societies, scientific groups, or individual microbiologists may nominate a candidate, indicating the reasons and providing a CV (of no more than two pages and, where appropriate, a list of publications in peer-reviewed journals, not extending beyond the last ten years). Members of the FEMS Executive Committee may not nominate candidates from their own country. | |
| Deadline for nomination | The deadline for nomination is January 10 of every second calendar year in which a FEMS Congress will be held. | |
| Selection panel | The FEMS Awards Board, in charge of analysing the nominations, consists of the President (convenor), the Vice President (deputy convenor), two Delegate Representatives elected by FEMS Council, and three <i>ad-hoc</i> members appointed by the FEMS Executive Committee. The latter should neither be members of the Executive Committee nor Council. | |
| Selection procedure | Out of the nominations received and on the basis of only quality criteria, the Awards Board proposes 6-10 candidates, in a ranked list, to the Executive Committee (choice and ranking have to be documented). | |
